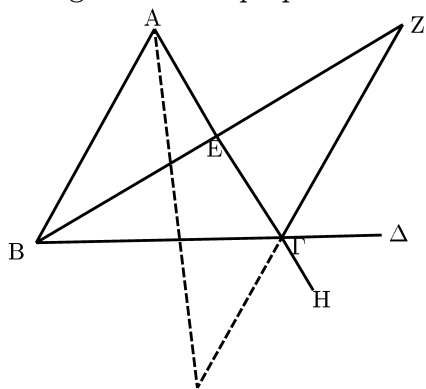


Errata in *SCIAMVS* Vol. 7

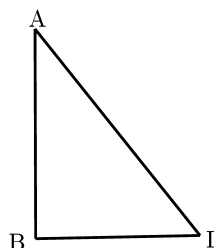
In the article “A preliminary study in the critical assessment of diagrams in Greek mathematical works” by Ken Saito, *SCIAMVS* 7(2006), 81–144, there is a typo and four figures should be replaced.

Page 95 line 1: The codex **P** is dated to 9th century (12th century is the date of **p**).

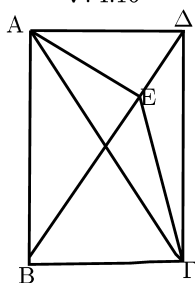
The figures of four propositions in codex **V** should be replaced by the following.



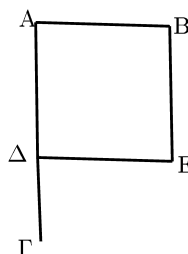
V: I.16



V: I.19



V: I.39



V: I.46

The diagram given for I.39 was that of codex **P** (the right image file seems to have been overwritten by some error in handling hundreds of them). For the other three propositions, the diagrams reproduced here have been improved by direct consultation of the manuscript: in I.16, dashed lines show erased lines; in I.19, the label A, which is very faint and was not visible in the reproduction, is restored; in I.46, the position of label Γ is corrected.

It should be noted that the lower part of the erased lines in I.16 go into the text area (the final part of this proposition). It is impossible that this erasure could have been done after the text was written. It is thus probable that the diagram was drawn in the course of copying the text.
